Did You Know...

A beneficiary must be enrolled in Medicare
 Part B in order to be covered for any Medicare
 preventive services





Preventive Services Overview

- Medicare pays for many preventive benefits,
- Preventive services support the health of Medicare beneficiaries by
 - Educating about potentially life-saving services and screenings
 - Early detection and/or prevention of diseases
 - Assisting with/suggesting lifestyle modifications





Screening for Lung Cancer with LDCT





Screening for Lung Cancer with LDCT

- National Coverage Determination 210.14
- Effective for dates of service on/after 2/5/2015
- Annual screening benefit when all criteria met
 - First screening
 - Subsequent screenings





2022 NCD Changes

- Effective for dates of service on/after 2/10/2022
 - Implementation date 10/3/2022 no mass adjustments
- MM12691 National Coverage Determination (NCD) 210.14 Reconsideration
 - Expanded patient eligibility, including lowering minimum age for screening
 - Removed restriction that physician/NPP must provide counseling and shared decision-making
 - Removed requirement of facility registry participation





Who is Covered

- Beneficiaries must meet all of the following
 - 50-77 years of age
 - 55-77 years for DOS prior to 2/10/2022
 - Asymptomatic
 - At least 20 pack-year tobacco smoking history
 - One pack-year = one 20-cigarette pack/day for one year
 - 30 pack year required for DOS prior to 2/10/2022
 - Current smoker or quit within last 15 years
 - Receive order for lung cancer screening with LDCT





Who Can Order

- For dates of service prior to 2/10/2022
- Qualified physicians and qualified nonphysician practitioners
 - NP
 - PA
 - CNS





Lung Cancer Screening Facilities

- For dates of service prior to 2/10/2022, must meet all criteria for providing service including
 - Requirements for reading radiologists and radiology imaging facilities
 - Collecting and submitting data to CMS-approved registry
 - American College of Radiology (ACR)





Lung Cancer Screening Facilities

- For dates of service on/after 2/10/2022
 - Must be furnished in a radiology imaging facility that utilizes standardized lung nodule identification, classification, and reporting system
 - Reading radiologist must have board certification or board eligibility with American Board of Radiology or equivalent organization





First vs. Subsequent Screenings

- For dates of service prior to 2/10/2022
 - Prior to first screening
 - Counseling and shared decision-making visit must occur with physician/qualified NPP
 - Written order with documentation furnished during visit
 - Subsequent screenings
 - Written orders may be furnished during any appropriate visit with physician/qualified NPP





Documentation for Counseling and Shared Decision-Making Visit

- Before beneficiary's first lung cancer LDCT screening, must receive counseling and shared decision-making visit
- Must be appropriately documented in beneficiary's medical record
- Must meet all of the following criteria
 - Determination of beneficiary eligibility for service
 - Shared decision-making (using one or more decision aids)





Documentation for Decision-Making Visit

- Counseling on
 - Importance of adherence to annual screening
 - Impact of comorbidities
 - Ability/willingness to undergo diagnosis and treatment
 - Importance of maintaining cigarette smoking abstinence if former smoker or importance of smoking cessation if current smoker
 - If appropriate, furnishing of information about tobacco cessation interventions





Orders

- Must include
 - Beneficiary date of birth
 - Actual pack-year smoking history (number)
 - Current smoking status/number of years since quitting smoking
 - Statement that beneficiary asymptomatic
 - NPI of ordering practitioner (for DOS prior to 2/10/2022)

Billing Requirements - Claim Level

- Report appropriate TOB
- Report appropriate ICD-10 diagnosis code
 - F17.210
 - F17.211
 - F17.213
 - F17.218
 - F17.219
 - **Z87.891**

Billing Requirements - Line Level

- Report appropriate revenue code
- Report appropriate HCPCS/CPT code

Code	Description		
G0296	Counseling visit to discuss need for lung cancer screening using LDCT (eligibility determination and shared decision making)		
71271	Computed tomography, thorax, low dose for lung cancer screening, without contrast material(s)		





Billing Instructions for RHCs and FQHCs

- Can only bill for G0296
- Counseling to discuss need for screening qualifies as stand-alone billable encounter
- If provided on same DOS as other billable encounter, report as incident to





Payment Methodology Based on Facility Type

Facility Type	Method of Payment	
Hospital Outpatient	OPPS	
SNF	MPFS	
RHC	AIR (G0296 only)	
FQHC	PPS (G0296 only)	
CAH Method I	101% reasonable cost for TC	
CAH Method II	Lesser of actual charge or 115% MPFSDB (G0296 only)	





Beneficiary Cost Sharing

- Coinsurance: waived
- Part B deductible: waived
 - Affordable Care Act





Why Claims are Denied

- Provider type/specialty cannot bill service
- Benefit maximum for this time period reached
- Procedure/code inconsistent with patient's age
- Diagnosis not covered
- FQHCs/RHCs Benefit for this service included in payment/allowance for another service/procedure already adjudicated





What You Should Do Now...

- Share this presentation with other internal staff members
- Talk to your patients about the importance of taking advantage of Medicare preventive services
- Update system with correct coding information
- Update any internal procedure to include verifying the patient's eligibility to receive preventive services to avoid costly, timeconsuming claim errors
