Shared Concepts to Effectively Communicate Frailty for Hospice and Palliative Care Provider: The clinical concept of "frailty" is an important factor in the care and management of all Medicare beneficiaries. While it may be represented on Medicare claims using ICD-10-CM R54 (age-related physical debility), there is no consensus, and therefore variation, concerning how best to communicate its impact on clinical decision-making so that its significance can be captured in the medical record documentation and claims supporting Medicare hospice and palliative care coverage and reimbursement. This session will define the concept of frailty and discuss how the concept of frailty applies to Medicare hospice claims. This session will also describe the steps necessary to improve the communication of frailty using a provider-payer collaborative approach.


