

	 Services typically start with a 60-minute face-to-face visit that includes a detailed history and patient exam. Use information you gather from the exam to create a written care plan.
10:30- 11:15 a.m.	Care Management: Advanced Care Planning
	 Covered voluntary service enabling Medicare patients to make important decisions dictating control over type of care received.
2:00- 3:00 p.m.	Care Management: Behavioral Health Integration and Psychiatric Collaborative Care Management
	 Services covered monthly, delivered using psychiatric collaborative care management, an approach to behavioral health integration, shown to improve patient outcomes in multiple studies.
